**Fender Piles Replacement Project**

Sealed bids for the removal and installation of eleven (11) fender piles on Citizens' Dock Road will be received by the Crescent City Harbor District ("Owner") at the Harbor District offices. All bids must be received by the Owner before 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 6, 2016. The bids will be opened publicly and read aloud at 4:15 p.m. on September 9, 2016. Bids must be addressed and labeled as follows:

"Bid for Fender Piles Replacement Project"

Prospective bidders may request a complete bid package ("Project Manual") by calling 707-464-6174. The work includes the furnishing of the labor, materials and equipment for the removal and installation of eleven (11) fender piles located on Citizens' Dock. The Harbor District will supply all new piles for installation and dispose of all piles removed. All work must be in accordance with Army Corps, State Water Board and Coastal Development permits, Fender Pile Replacement Plans and applicable state law, rules and regulations.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bidder's security in the form of a bond or a certified or cashier's check payable to the order of the Owner in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bidder's bid as a guarantee that if it is awarded the contract, the bidder will execute the contract in conformity with the bid form. The successful bidder will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds, each in an amount equal to the total contract price.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to determine which bid is, in the Owner's judgment, the lowest responsive bid. Bids received after the time established for receiving bids will not be considered.

Bidders are hereby notified that this is a public works project subject to prevailing wage.
