DONATIONS TO RAISE MONEY TO CREATE THE REQUIRED RESERVE ACCOUNT

BOARD APPROVAL & ANSWERS NEEDED FOR:

1. Generic letter requesting donation on CCHD letterhead with your TAX-ID #.
2. Letter giving me permission to solicit donations and set up on harbor property
3. How would you like the cash to be secured – do you have a cash box? Do you accept checks? Please provide how you would like checks to be addressed to. Does CCHD have a Zelle account with their checking to accept cashless payments via the app? Or Venmo?

DETAILS

- 1 or 2 - 6 ft tables with 2 chairs at each table under a portable shade tent - depending on how many volunteers I can get to work the table(s) there could be one at south beach end and one at the marina end of Harbor property
- No food or beverage will be offered because of County permit and application requirements and the short planning window
- No raffle will be possible because of state requirements and the short planning window
- The tables will offer direct sale of Harbor Merchandise from the Gift Shop and all Donated Items and Gift Cards from our community businesses – such as these listed below that I have already spoken with:

Safeway, Home Depot, Wild River, Sun Seekers, Johnstons Gifts

- I will seek gift cards and merchandise from a lot of local restaurants and some other businesses near the Harbor after Board Approval.
- I will combine items into attractive gift baskets and offer them for sale at the following 5 price points: \$10, \$20, \$30, \$50, \$100
- Ace Rental has 6ft tables \$9/day and Chairs \$2.50 each per day
- Home Depot will donate one shade tent that can be kept at Harbor and used for future events
- I will seek another shade tent to be donated by Walmart or Big 5

(Janice confirmed that the tent the harbor had before broke.)

I will use the attached DONATIONS INVENTORY CHART to document and track the donations received and those which are sold at the event and the amount of money collected.

Any leftover items can be sold at the Harbor Gift Shop and/or retained for another fundraiser.

I'm happy to help the harbor while enjoying this very special 250th Anniversary of our country's Independence. I am so glad that the culture has changed and I can safely do so!
